

Hi fellow flyers

This year the Canadian International Air Show (CIAS) is celebrating its 70th Anniversary at the Canadian National Exhibition. TEAMAC has been invited to participate with a static display of club members aircraft. So far I have 2 Red Arrows (Royal Air Force Red Arrows will be performing) a MIG 19 (also appearing), an F-22 Raptor; a T28 Trojan and a glider. The aircraft will be on display at the CIAS VIP site which is on the south side of Lakeshore Blvd. at the west end of the CNE grounds (south of western most building on the CNE grounds)

While on display they will be housed in a secure area where visitors may look, but not touch. At night they will be moved to a covered enclosure and 24 hour security will be in effect. While I can appreciate that members would probably not want to tie up three days of a long weekend, if you would agree I would personally look after your aircraft at the site. The CIAS will have a sign made signifying that the aircraft are provided by TEAMAC (Georgetown flyers have also indicated that they would like to participate)

The CIAS are prepared to provide Air Show Tickets to the VIP site to members participating in the display. A CF18 cockpit is also being planned to be displayed in the area.

I am still looking for the following – F86 Sabre; Corsair; Snow Bird Tudors; Mosquitoes: Vampires; Lancaster (which may also be appearing the show); Spitfires, Hurricanes; Harvards; I believe a club member has an Air Cadet Glider (which also will be appearing in the show); CL 415 Waterbomber; WWI Aircraft and other jets.
